# TOURNAMENT FORMAT



### B.A.S.S. NATION

B.A.S.S. directs each state to determine who their #1 boater and #1 nonboater are going to be, for us that will be the Utah Angler of the Year (UT AOY).

- Utah AOYs advance directly to the B.A.S.S. NATION CHAMPIONSHIP

#### There are no more western divisional tournaments as done in the previous years

B.A.S.S. host a REGIONAL TOURNAMENT that will be conducted at 4 different areas of the U.S.

- UTBN receives 10 each, guaranteed state team boater and non-boater slots to a Regional.
- UTBN state team members still receive all the sponsor discounts/benefits as in previous years.
- UTBN designated regional location is determined by B.A.S.S. (Entry fee will be \$400 boater and \$200 nonboater).
- Top 20 anglers (Boaters and non-boaters) from <u>each</u> Regional advance to the BASS NATION CHAMPIONSHIP
- At the BASS NATION CHAMPIONSHIP Up for grabs is an Elite series invite, 3 spots for the Bassmaster Classic, and opportunity to win boat and money, etc.

## NEW UTBN TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Starting in 2025 this is a quick overview on our tournament operation and how we will determine the UTBN State Team and UTBN AOYs

Hold 6 tournaments per calendar year, each tournament will be considered a stand-alone single day Tournament.

- All tournament days are a shared weight format i.e. the boater and nonboater team will work together to bring their combined heaviest 5 fish limit to the scales.
- Both the boater and the nonboater are awarded the combined total weight for each tournament day.
- Tournaments #1, #2 and #3 will be 21-23 March out of Bullfrog, UT and will determine 5 boaters and 5 non-boaters for the state team (based off total points for 3 days)
- Tournaments #4, #5, and #6 will be 31 October 2 November out of Bullfrog, UT and will determine 5 boaters and 5 non-boaters for the state team (based off total points for 3 days)
- Points are accrued for each finishing position starting at 100 pts first place, 99 for second place, 98 for third place, etc. for <u>EACH</u> tournament day. Total points accrued over the 3-days at March tournaments will determine ½ the state team members. The other ½ of the state team will be based off points accrued over 3-days at October tournaments.
- Each tournament day will be paid out as a single Tournament (FOR EXAMPLE: If you win tournament #1 on you receive 100 pts and get paid, if you suck on tournament #2 and finish last you get last place points and do not get paid, then you figure it out and finish third on tournament #3 you get 98 points and third place money).
- Positions paid will be determined by number of participants in the Tournament (typically 1 spot paid for every 6 contestants)
- State team members (5 boaters and 5 non-boaters) from each of the March and November tournaments will make up the UT State Team and be eligible to compete at the Regional Tournament
- UT AOYs will be determined based off total points accrued <u>from all 6 tournament days</u>.
- #1 boater and #1 non-boater will be considered UT AOYs and advance directly to the B.A.S.S. Nation Championship.
