Greetings Utah BASS Nation Anglers—Just wanted to get some information out as we start spinning up for the final tournament of the year.

- Up for grab are the remaining 10 spots on the 2022 state team along with an expected payout of over \$10,000 in prize money (based on field size).
- ♦ Please start getting paired up between boaters and nonboaters so we can obtain maximum participation.
- ♦ Deadline for having entry forms and fees submitted to Billy Ricker is 30 October 2021, otherwise a late fee of \$25 may be incurred.
- All boaters must have completed the online quagga mussel course and be able to provide proof of completion at the pretournament registration and to Utah DNR when asked.
- ♦ Pre-Tournament registration/check-in/payment in to option pots and sponsor raffle will be conducted at the pavilions adjacent to the fish cleaning station area inside the park starting at 3:00 on Thursday 4 November.
- ♦ Covid 19 Protocols and social distancing rules will be in effect.
- ♦ Sponsor product giveaway, raffle and partner pairing will be conducted starting at 4:00
- ♦ Shout out to Ron Colby for assisting the UTBN in obtaining a 15% discount on lodging at Defiance house—if you are staying there please be sure to use the codes, also be sure to understand the rates, taxes, fees. Code for the STATE TEAM QUALIFIER IS UTBN21
- ♦ Lake Powell will be at an all time low which equates to plenty of unseen obstacles and hazards. Please be extremely careful when exploring and traveling throughout the entire reservoir since lots of unknown shallow areas may not be shown or obvious on your GPS or Lake Map system.
- ♦ 2022 Western Divisional is scheduled to be held at Lake Havasu AZ, 16-18 February (which should be significantly better fishing than what was experienced in 2021)
- Tom Nokes and Ben Byrd are heading to the BASS Nation Championship on the Ouachita River out of Monroe Louisiana during the first week of November, please wish them luck.
- Dobyns rods can now be purchased directly from the OEM no waiting or requesting of certificates is required, the good folks at Dobyns have a copy of the UTBN members roster so if you are looking to upgrade equipment just call 903-919-8028 ask for Chelsie, and let her know you are a member of the Utah BASS Nation and she will get you taken care of. Social distancing must be practiced to maximum extent possible This event is a random draw tournament. Guests may fish this event if there are open spots at an additional cost of \$15.
